

Competition Drives Costs Down

PPAs from developers have been consistently cheaper than utility owned projects and remain the lowest cost option for ratepayers. Power Purchase Agreement contract prices have decreased more than 60% since 2009, and Utility-Owned projects have seen prices fall approximately 52% between 2010 and 2015.

Costs have been much lower than expected and have continued to decline.
